PRACTICE/SEASON CANCELLATION & RESCHEDULING

At Loudoun Elite Volleyball, we prioritize the consistency and quality of our practices to ensure optimal player development. However, we acknowledge that unforeseen circumstances may occasionally lead to the cancellation of scheduled practices. These circumstances may include:

- 1. Sports Facility Unforeseen Events: Last-minute closures or unavailability of sports facilities due to maintenance, facility emergencies, or scheduling conflicts.
- <u>2. Inclement Weather:</u> Adverse weather conditions, such as severe storms, heavy rain, lightning, or extreme temperatures, pose safety risks to players and coaches during outdoor practices.
- 3. Other Possible Reasons: Other unforeseen events or emergencies that may arise, such as power outages, facility accidents, epidemics/pandemics, or other factors beyond the control of the club.

Indoor Volleyball

In the event of a practice cancellation by either the sports facility or the club, Loudoun Elite Volleyball will make every effort to reschedule the canceled practice. However, it's important to note that the club does not guarantee that practices will be rescheduled. No refunds will be issued in case of non-rescheduled practices.

Beach Volleyball

For beach volleyball, Loudoun Elite Volleyball will apply the same policy as for indoor volleyball regarding practice cancellations and rescheduling. This includes practices that are cancelled either by the sports facility or the club due to inclement weather.

Exceptional Circumstances

In the case of a tragedy or extraordinary event (such as a major accident, fire, natural disaster, epidemic/pandemic, or other force majeure events) that necessitates the cancellation of the entire season, Loudoun Elite Volleyball will not issue refunds or cancel future payments. The reason for not issuing refunds or canceling future payments is that the majority of the club's expenses occur prior to tryouts and the beginning of the season, and the majority of those expenses are non-refundable. We incur significant costs in preparing for the season, including facility rentals, equipment purchases, coaching staff salaries, and administrative expenses. These expenses are essential for the operation of the club and are incurred regardless of whether the season proceeds as planned. We understand the financial implications of such circumstances, but the decision to cancel the season due to extraordinary events is made in the interest of the safety and well-being of our players, coaches, and families.
