USA VOLLEYBALL PARENT/SPECTATOR CODES OF CONDUCT

By registering online for a program with Loudoun Elite Volleyball the parent/guardian agrees with the following:

In addition to the <u>USAV Event Code of Conduct</u> (available online) and in consideration of the rights granted to me through my child's membership with the Regional Volleyball Association (RVA) and USA Volleyball (USAV) RVA member, I consent to abide by the rules of conduct set forth herein while my child is a member of the Chesapeake Region Volleyball Association (CHRVA). I understand that these rules extend to my conduct and my guests' conduct during activities related to, and at any USAV/RVA and other officially sanctioned events in which my child participates. I understand that the violation of the following rules could result in my removal from events or my child's dismissal from the club:

- Remain in the spectator areas during all games.
- Do not advise the coach on how to coach, who to put in the game, or who to take out of the game.
- Do not coach my child in practices and/or tournaments.
- Respect the integrity of the officials and do not advise them on how to call the match.
- Model sportsmanship for my child by treating all coaches, officials, tournament directors, and players of either team with courtesy and respect.
- Encourage hard work and honest effort that will lead to improved performance and participation.
- Emphasize the cooperative nature of the sport.
- Encourage/enforce athletes to participate in the volleyball drug, tobacco, and alcohol-free policies.
- Attend all volleyball events respecting the drug, tobacco, and alcohol-free policies.
- Cheer for my child's team.
- Encourage my child to participate for enjoyment as well as competition.
- Applaud good and fair play during matches.
- Be in control of my emotions.
- Learn the rules of the game to help me better understand what is happening on the court.
- Understand that physical or verbal intimidation of any individual is unacceptable behavior.
- Be supportive of all attempts to remove verbal or physical abuse from organized volleyball activities, including language.
- Protect the ability to continue using the facility by following all the rules of the facility, such as NO FOOD, DRINK, OR COOLERS IN THE GYM, smoking in designated areas only, and throwing all trash in an appropriate receptacle, etc.
- Protect athletes from sanctions and/or suspension by providing accurate documentation.
- Honor financial commitments.
